What to Bring

Bible, bed sheets and blanket or sleeping bag, pillow, clothes for a week, towels and wash clothes, personal hygiene items (toothpaste, brush, deodorant), bug repellent, flashlight. Please write your child's name on each item.



What Not to Bring

No radios or electronic equipment including Game-Boys or MP3 players, no weapons including knives. Do not bring money as all meals and snacks will be provided. Do not bring clothing like see-thru tops, exposed midriffs, or tank-tops. Shorts must be hands length (minimum of 4 inch inseam).

Expected Behavior

While we do not assume that each child will be a perfect angel, campers are expected to follow the rules of the camp. Foul language, fighting, and general disobedience will not be tolerated. Those who misbehave will face consequences (i.e., lost swim time). Any child who refuses to follow the rules will be sent home. It will be the responsibility of the parent to come pick up their child at camp if they are dismissed early for poor behavior.



Meds

All meds will be distributed by the camp nurse. If necessary, send detailed instructions for the nurse.
