

FEDERAL PRISON OUTREACH MINISTRY

The Federal Prison Outreach Ministry is a team of staff members of the ministry and volunteers who travel to various Federal Prisons across the United States conducting Spiritual Renewal Seminars. A theme is selected each year with a Life Skill application in mind. These seminars are developed to provide an uplifting experience for those incarcerated. There is time for praise and worship; skits are performed; and lessons are presented on the theme. Facilities where the team has traveled: Mark Luttrell Correctional Complex, a women's facility in Memphis, Tennessee; the Tennessee Prison for Women in Nashville, Tennessee; the Correctional Development Center for women of the Metropolitan-Davidson County Sheriff's Department; the Federal Correctional Institution for men and the Federal Prison Camp for women in Marianna, Florida; the Federal Prison Camp for women in Greenville, Illinois; the U. S. Penitentiary in Leavenworth, Kansas; the U. S. Penitentiary for men, the Federal Prison Camp for men and the Federal Correctional Complex for men in Tucson, Arizona; the Federal Prison Camp for women in Alderson, WV; the Federal Medical Center for women in Fort Worth, Texas, the Federal Correctional Institution for men and the Federal Prison Camp for women in Phoenix, Arizona; the Federal Prison Camp for men in Goldsboro, North Carolina before it closed; the Federal Medical Center for men and the Federal Prison Camp for women in Lexington, Kentucky; the U. S. Penitentiary for men in Pine Knot, Kentucky as well as other institutions over the years. This ministry has made an effort to develop a good relationship with the chaplains to encourage them up as well. We are continually looking for volunteers to travel with this team.
